




30% of Malaysians are aware of cryptocurrencies but less than 5% own any

Are you aware of cryptocurrencies?




Do you currently own any cryptocurrencies?



Cryptocurrency Awareness




Malaysians who are aware of cryptocurrencies mainly reside in the central and northern region, are of Malay & Chinese ethnicity, and in their mid-20s


Bitcoin and Ethereum are the two most popular cryptocurrencies owned by Malaysians



Bitcoin's Perception in Malaysia



Bitcoin perceived as a currency and/or asset.



The general perception for Bitcoin is **mostly neutral**. Almost half of the participants (**45%**) see it **as a currency**. A small fraction (**8%**) perceives **Bitcoin as a scam** perhaps due to past scam incidents involving Bitcoin as well as its semi-regulated status.

Some of the events contributing to **negative outlook** for Bitcoin:


- (2013) Shutdown of Silk Road dark web drug marketplace which used Bitcoin by the FBI.
- (<u>2017</u>) Bitcoin suffered an 80% loss within 10 months after its peak of RM 80,224 in Dec 2017
- (2019, 2020) Locally, there have been several instances of illegal mining operators being caught by the police for electricity theft.

Malaysia's Securities Commission (SC) has sought to regulate this industry by putting in place regulations and giving out licenses to 3 digital asset exchanges. SC is also actively adding a list of unauthorized websites, investment products, companies and individuals into its **Investor Alert List**.




Most Malaysian cryptocurrency users made their first purchase during the 2017 bubble






38% of Malaysians perceive cryptocurrencies to be too risky




Do you intend to buy cryptocurrencies in the next 12 months?




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
Exchanges are the preferred transaction method, Luno dominating the local market








How do you do your research on cryptocurrencies?




Top-7 Social Media used to do research on cryptocurrencies








Do you have any savings?

Key Takeaways





- Only **29%** of Malaysians are aware of cryptocurrencies
- 5% owns at least one cryptocurrency



- 45% of Malaysians think Bitcoin is just a currency
- 8% think that Bitcoin is a scam or fraud



- 56% of Malaysians crypto users use Luno as their preferred fiat-to-crypto on-ramp of choice
- More than 20% prefer international exchanges as there are more trading pairs available



- More than 57% of Malaysian users do their cryptocurrency research using social media
- They are especially influenced by content on Facebook and YouTube



- Most Malaysians are not financially resourceful
- Almost 40% of respondents do not invest at all or rely on fixed deposit as their primary investment
